Community Garden Guidelines

Welcome to the Streams of Hope Community Garden!

Participating in a community garden can be a fun, rewarding and educational experience. It is an opportunity to meet your neighbors, share what you know with others and learn new things. Streams of Hope staff and volunteers are here to help make this year as successful as possible for you. These guidelines are designed to answer your questions and help us all have an enjoyable and successful year gardening together. Please contact us if at any time you have any questions or concerns.

Stream of Hope will provide:

- Garden plot with locked gate.
- Some garden tools such as shovels, garden hoe, etc. available for general use. They should always be stored in the tool shed when not being used. The tool shed will be secured with a lock. You may, at your own risk, store your personal tools in this shed, space permitting. Streams of Hope is not responsible for lost or stolen personal goods.
- Water – 5 faucets are available within the garden.
- Opportunities to learn more about growing a successful garden; opportunities to meet other gardeners; a relaxing and fun gardening experience. In addition, Streams of Hope may be able to provide a limited number of plants/seeds to get you started.

What may be grown or placed in your plot:

- Vegetables, herbs, flowers and/or small fruit plants.
- Plants or small trees which are placed into pots or containers (you must remove these at the end of the season). All containers must fit within your plot.
- No perennials or overwintering root vegetables planted in the ground.
- All plants must be legal and for personal consumption or donation only.
- No trees or large/permanent structures may be planted or stored on Streams Of Hope property.

Plot care guidelines:

- All plots must be watered, weeded and generally maintained on a regular basis. Plots must be kept clean of refuse and always have a neat appearance.
- Dispose of plant waste in the yard waste carts in the trash enclosure and trash in the can or dumpster.
- Plants must not grow outside the bounds of your plot (within reason), and may not obstruct any paths or others' plots.
- Be considerate of your neighbors and orient your structures and plantings to avoid casting shade on other plots.
- Be sure to turn off the water when you are finished using it.
- Streams of Hope reserves the right to remove any plants or other materials that may interfere with another Community Garden member's plot.
- Please notify Streams of Hope if you can no longer maintain your plot.
- All plots must be cleared and cleaned by November 10. Those who don't clear their plot may lose the opportunity for a plot the following year. Any possessions still remaining after this date will become the property of Streams of Hope.
- Tampering in any way with any garden plot other than your own is not allowed.
- Gardeners found in non-compliance with these guidelines may be asked to forfeit their plot. We will be monitoring the garden on a regular basis.
- We ask everyone for help in keeping a well-maintained and inviting garden for all.

Regarding general conduct and personal responsibility:

- Please respect the personal property, garden plots, and the hard work of others. Do not infringe on other plots. This would include using caution when moving a hose. Remember...If you expect respect, be the first to show it.
- Personal radios, cell phones or electronic games are not forbidden at the garden, but please keep their volume to a minimum or use headphones.
- Please closely supervise young children and pets at the garden, and never leave animals or children unattended on Streams of Hope property. You must keep dogs and other pets OUTSIDE the garden fence and away from children and other animals. Please be courteous and always clean up after your children and pets.
- Regarding theft: Theft of produce or tools is a small but unfortunate occurrence among community gardens. Our fence can keep many animals out but not those intent to do harm. To reduce the chance of theft, harvest your produce as soon as it is ripe, and do not leave personal belongings or crops at the garden overnight. Please report any theft or suspicious behavior immediately.
